

North Conway, NH (NCON3) Monthly Weather Summary

April 2021

Summary

April 2021 wrapped up as warmer and slightly drier than normal. The mean temperature for the month was 46.2F, which is roughly 4F warmer than normal. The vast majority of the month featured minimum temperatures that were above the freezing mark with just 0.2 inches of snowfall recorded.

Following the least snowy March on record, April was 4.2 inches below normal for snowfall, adding to the deficit for the full winter season. Snowfall from July 2020 through April 2021 is now 35.2 inches below normal for the season. This snowfall season has totaled just 44.8 inches, which is still well above the least snowy winter on record which was just 27.0 inches in 1974. April continued the windy trend this spring with four days featuring gusts above 25 MPH, with a monthly peak of 33 MPH from the west on the 22nd.
